- (iv) Post Graduation in Geography or Economics or Sociology

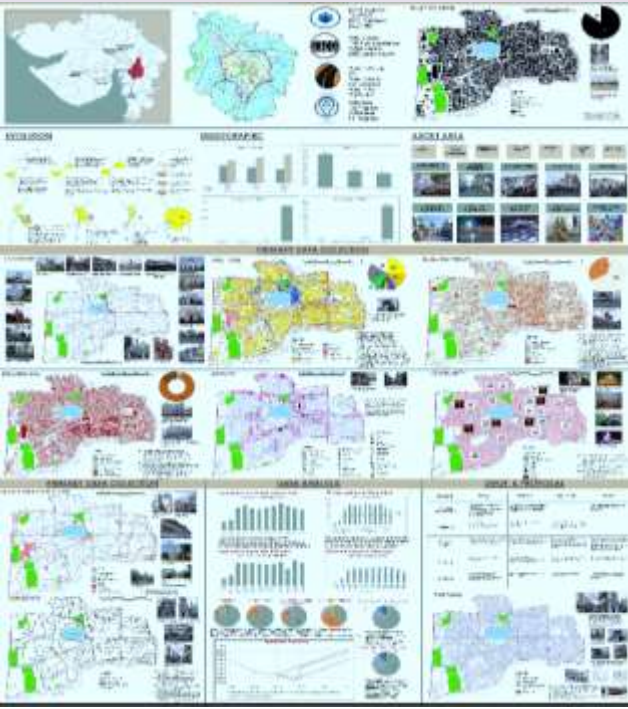
