The Programme began with the welcome address of Prof. C N Murthy, Dean Faculty of Technology and Engineering. He deliberated the importance of programme which is to consolidate data of NAAC Criteria Criteria 1 – Curricular Aspects, Criteria 2 - Teaching Learning and Evaluation, Criteria 3 - Research, Innovations and Extension, Criteria 4 - Infrastructure and Learning Resources, Criteria 5 - Student Support and Progression, Criteria 6 - Governance, Leadership and Management, Criteria 7 - Institutional Values and Best Practices.

The programme was attended by the HOD's, Senior teachers, Department and Faculty Coordinators.

The Dean of the faculty welcomed Hon'ble Vice Chancellor and gave an overview on the preparation for NAAC.

Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Parimal Vyas further discussed and explained all 1 to 7 Criteria and 115 metrics for NAAC 2021. He emphasized to prepare data for NAAC at Faculty level rather than departmental one. He also shared a tentative date of NAAC- 2021 visit and date of sending data for DVV. He also asked IQAC Convener to conduct a SWOT analysis of the Faculty and get a published copy of the all activities of the Faculty. Hon'ble Vice Chancellor also emphasized that Faculty can come out with various publications. He answered various questions and solved doubts of the Faculty IQAC members. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor felt that although this faculty is relatively small, it can contribute greatly to make a positive impact in the overall NAAC. A part of the presentation was dedicated to the supporting documents needed for these Quantitative & Qualitative metrics and he explained the same at great length.

The Director, IQAC said that there is good progress in the compilation of Quantitative metrics. He informed about the pending issues, data and documentation from the Faculty and requested Hon'ble Vice Chancellor to address the teachers with the presentation specially made for the faculty.
