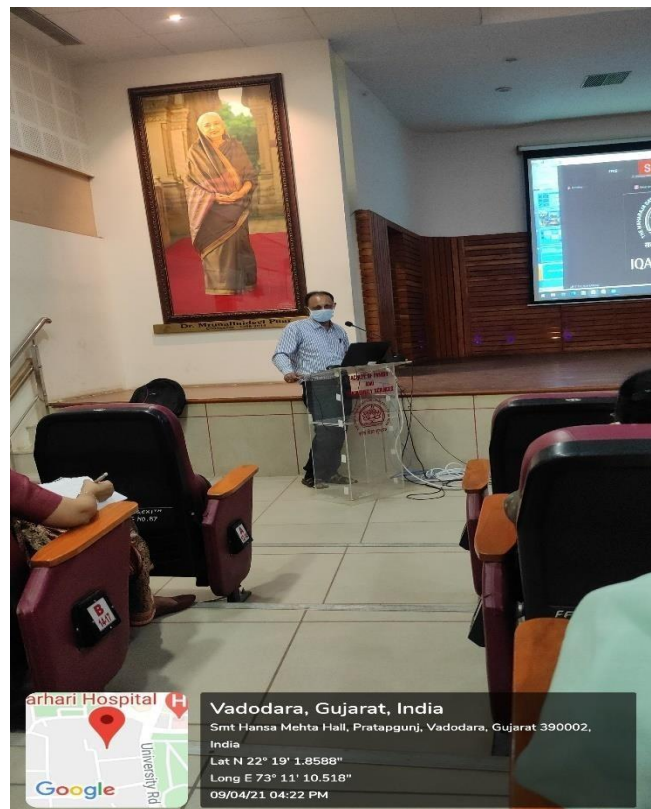
**Presentation by Prof.

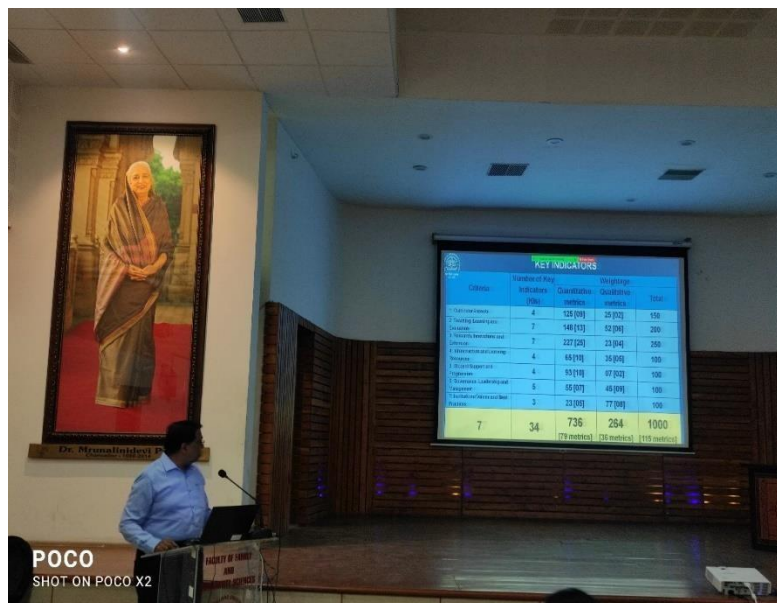
