With a view to guide the students on issues pertaining to online safety a Webinar was organized by Faculty of Law, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda, on the topic of 'Cybersafety in Cyberspace'. A renowned Advocate of Supreme Court of India Dr. Karnika Seth, was invited to talk upon the areas pertaining to Cybersaftey.


The distinguished speaker was welcomed by Prof. (Dr.) Bhavna Mehta, Dean (OSD), Faculty of Law, The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda.

Dr. Karnika discussed about how and to what extent cyber crimes have doubled in India, and more specifically during this Covid 19 times. According to the data only in Maharashtra during this Covid 19, cyber crimes have increased by 25%. Dr. Karnika emphasised on why we need to protect our children when they are online, as they are exposed to attacks by paedophiles, child predators, and other cyber criminals. Dr. Seth also pointed out that India has large amount of cases pertaining to online sexual abused children. She pointed out that not only children but women are also being harassed by cyber criminals through invasion of their privacy, morphed pictures, revenge porn etc. Dr. Seth elaborately discussed various provisions of Information Technology Act 2000 and various provisions of Indian Penal Code. Dr. Karnika also discussed various provisions pertaining to phishing, identity theft, and cheating under Information Technology Act 2000. One of the important aspects of the speech of Dr. Karnika was, that she discussed the best practices that onw should adopt to be safe while online. She emphasise upon a need for cyber awareness in schools, sensitisation of parents and teachers, and internal complaints committee against sexual harassment. Dr. Seth elaborately discussed on various tools to detect fake news. Dr. Seth also discussed on various important provisions pertaining to Personal Data Protection Bill 2019.

More than 1300 people registered for webinar from various part of country out of which some were from Afginastan, Bolivia, Romania and United Kingdom.

The entire event was successfully convened by Dr. G A Solanki and Dr R I Parikh with the support of young faculty members' team under the guidance of Prof. Bhavna Mehta.
